OF MINNESOTA FOR 1881.

CHAPTER 105.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO (2) OF CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND SIX (206) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878,) AND TO REPEAL CHAP-TER TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY (260) OF TAE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (1879). RELATING TO THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF CATTLE AND OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS IN RICE COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of chapter two hundred and six of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventyeight (1878) be amended by striking out all after the word animals, in the fourth (4th) line of said section.

SEC. 2. That chapter two hundred and sixty (260) of the Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879) be, and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 106.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND FORTY-FOUR (244) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOU-SAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (1877.) RELATING TO THE CANNON RIVER MANUFACTURING ASSOCIATION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter two hundred and forty-four (244) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877) be, and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "the State Auditor" occurring in lines three and four of said act as printed and published.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
