

CHAPTER 161.

AN ACT to add certain territory to Faribault school district number one (1), in Rice county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the most southerly sixteen (16) acres of the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section nineteen (19) in township one hundred and ten (110), north of range twenty (20) west, in Rice county, be and the same is hereby detached from common school district number twenty-five (25) and attached and joined to Faribault special school district number one (1) of said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 162.

AN ACT to detach certain territory therein described from independent school district number one (1), in Polk county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all that portion of independent school district number one (1), of Polk county, which lies south of Red Lake river, except lots two (2), three (3), four (4), seven (7) and the southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), and the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section of [number] thirty-six (36) of town one hundred and fifty (150) of range forty-seven (47), is hereby detached from said independent school district and shall form and after the passage of this act constitute no part thereof.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
