CHAPTER 174.

AN ACT to detach certain territory therein described, from independent school district number one (1) in Polk county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all of sections ten (10), eleven (11), twelve (12), thirteen (13), fourteen (14), fifteen (15), twenty-two (22), twenty-three (23), twenty-four (24), and all that portion of sections twenty-six (26) and twenty-seven (27), all in township number one hundred and fifty (150), north of range forty-seven (47) west, in Polk county, be and the same is hereby detached from and shall hereafter constitute no part or portion of independent school district number one (1) of Polk county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and aften its passage.

CHAPTER 175.

AN ACT to authorize and require the city of Minneapolis to assume and provide for the payment of certain bonded indebtedness of school district number one hundred and nineteen (119), in Hennepin county.

Whereas by an act of the present legislature, the city limits of the city of Minneapolis were extended so as to include a portion of school district number one hundred and nineteen (119), in the county of Hennepin, together with the school house of said school district. And whereas there is an outstanding bonded debt of said school district amounting to the sum of six thousand and five hundred (6.500) dollars, incurred in the construction of said school house therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesola:

SECTION 1. That it shall be the duty of the said city of Minneapolis to assume and provide by taxation for the payment of the principal and interest of the said bonded debt as the same shall mature. *Provided*, that all taxes hitherto levied within that portion of said school district within the limits of said city as so, extened, for the payment of the said bonded debt or the interest thereon or for the support of schools, shall when collected, be paid over to the treasurer of said city of Minneapolis and be devoted to the purposes for which the same were levied.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
