CHAPTER 176.

AN ACT creating a joint School District in Mower and Freeborn Counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the territory consisting of the west half of section six (6), the whole of seven (7) and the west half of section eighteen (18), in township one hundred and four (104), range eighteen (18), in the county of Mower, Minnesota, and sections one (1), twelve (12) and thirteen (13), and the southeast quarter of section two (2) and the northeast puarter of section eleven (11), in township one hundred and four (104 in range nineteen (19) in the county of Freeborn, Minnesota, shall constitute and be a school district by the name of school district number ———, under the general school laws of the State.

[Section 2. That said school district shall be governed by the

general school laws of this state.]

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT to detach certain territory from School District number fifty-eight (58) in Rice county, and attach the same to School District number fifty-nine (59) in said county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The southwest quarter of section seventeen (17), in township one hundred and twelve (112), north of range twenty-two (22) west, is hereby detached from school district number fifty-eight (58), in Rice county, and attached to school district number fifty nine (59) in said county and made a part of the same.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.
