CHAPTER 209.

AN ACT to authorize the city council of the city of Minneapolis to appropriate money to aid in the opening and completion of certain roads in Hennepin county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the city council of the city of Minneapolis is hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate such reasonable sum of money as they may deem necessary and expedient, payable out of the general city fund, to aid in the opening, working and completion of two (2) certain public highways in the county of Hennepin, more particularly described in chapter three hundred and thirty-four (334) of the Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879), and in extending the said highways into the city of Minneapolis, and in opening and working the same, as extended, within said city, or either of the same.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.

Approved February 23, 1881.

CHAPTER 210.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the city council of the city of Minneapolis to lay out and extend certain streets through Maple Hill cemetery, in said city.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the city council of the city of Minneapolis be and hereby is authorized and empowered to lay out and extend Broadway and Fillmore streets, in the city of Minneapolis, through Maple Hill cemetery, in said city, on the present line of said streets, and to open and work the same suitable for public travel.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
