CHAPTER 305.

AN ACT to appropriate money to build a bridge across the Pomme De Terre river in Grant county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesola:

SECTION 1. That the sum of two hundred dollars, (\$200) or so much thereof as may be required, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the State treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first moneys that shall come into the State treasury belonging to said fund, not otherwise appropriated, to build a good and substantial bridge across the Pomme De Terre river, on section seven (7), town of Land, in said county of Grant; said bridge, when completed, to be and remain forever free from toll, and be kept in repair by the said county of Grant.

SEC. 2. Said bridge shall be built under the direction of the board of supervisors of the town of Land, in said county of Grant, and no part of said appropriation shall be paid out of the State treasury until the completion of the bridge above mentioned.

SEC. 3. Erick Olsen, Christian Peterson and Peter Nordin are hereby appointed a committee, on the part of the State, to view and examine said bridge as soon as completed, and to examine all contracts, papers and accounts respecting its construction, and to fix and decide the cost thereof, and to report to the State auditor the sum said contractor or contractors shall be entitled to under the contracts, agreements or specifications relating to the construction of the bridge aforesaid.

SEC. 4. Any two (2) of said committee may act in the premises, and in case two (2) of said committee cannot be found, or refuse to act, it is hereby made the duty of the county auditor of Grant county to investigate and examine all papers, vouchers and contracts relating to the building of said bridge, and to estimate its value, and report, at his earliest convenience, all the facts to the State auditor, who shall then have full authority to issue an order or draft, in favor of the county treasurer, on the State treasurer, for the amount found to be due for the construction of the bridge required, not exceeding the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200).

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
