SPECIAL LAWS

CHAPTER 306.

AN ACT to prevent the running at large of cattle, horses or other domestic animals in the county of Traverse, in the State of Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to allow cattle, horses, sheep, swine or other domestic animals, owned by such person or persons, or of which such person or persons have control, or may be in possession, to run at large upon any highway, or upon the lands of any other person or persons in the county of Traverse, in the State of Minnesota, during any season of the year, unless they are carefully herded.

SEC. 2. Any person or persons who shall violate or neglect the provisions of the first section of this act, shall be liable for all damages that may ensue in consequence of the trespass of such animal or animals.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 307.

AN ACT to prevent the running at large of cattle[or other domestic animals] in the towns of Stillwater and Baytown, of Washington county, State of Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to allow any cattle, horses, mules, sheep or swine owned by such person or persons or of which such person or persons have control or may be in possession of, to run at large upon any public highway or upon the lands of any other person or persons in the towns of Stillwater and Baytown, in the county of Washington, State of Minnesota, during any season of the year unless they are carefully herded.

SEC. 2. Any person or persons who shall violate or neglect the provisions of the first section of this act. shall be liable for all damages that may occur in consequence of the trespass of such animal or animals.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from its passage. Approved March 4, 1881.
