

## CHAPTER 311.

AN ACT relating to the running at large of cattle, horses, sheep, swine and other domestic animals, in the county of Houston, in the State of Minnesota.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to allow cattle, horses, sheep, swine or other domestic animals owned by such person or persons, or of which such person or persons have control, or who may be in the possession of the same, to run at large upon any of the public highways, or upon the lands of any other person or persons, in the county of Houston, in the State of Minnesota, during any season of the year, unless they are carefully herded.

SEC. 2. The owner or owners, or any person or persons having control, or having in possession, of any cattle, horses, sheep, swine, or other domestic animals, as aforesaid, shall be liable in an action at law for all damages done by such animals, without regard to any fence, or the sufficiency of any fence or fences on the lands on which the damage is done. The provisions of this act shall apply only to the township of Blackhammer, of said Houston county.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 312.

AN ACT to prohibit cattle and other domestic animals from running at large in township one hundred and twenty-one (121) range thirty-nine (39) in the county of Swift and State of Minnesota.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to allow any cattle, horses, asses, mules, sheep, or swine owned by such person or persons or of which such person or persons have control or may be in possession of, to run at large on any public highway, or upon the lands of any other person or persons in township one hundred and twenty-one (121) range thirty-nine (39) called
