

CHAPTER 320.

AN ACT to legalize the organization of the town of Clontarf, in the county of Swift, and all acts of the officers of said town under said organization.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the organization of the town of Clontarf, in the county of Swift, State of Minnesota, be and the same is hereby legalized, and that all official acts of the respective town officers of said town of Clontarf, under and by virtue of said organization, are hereby declared legal and valid in all respects.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 321.

AN ACT to legalize a deed of conveyance acknowledged before George Bligh Bowen, esquire, commissioner of police and magistrate of the city of Madras, East India.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That a certain deed of conveyance, executed by Mrs. Harriet B. Scott and Douglas Scott, conveying certain real estate situate in Ramsey county, in this State, to Alice K. Merrill, which deed was acknowledged before George Bligh Brown, esquire, commissioner of police and magistrate of the city of Madras, East India, on the tenth (10th) day of February, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two (1872), in due form of law, which deed is of record in the office of the register of deeds of said Ramsey county, in book fifty-three (53), record of deeds, page three hundred and fifty-eight (358), is hereby legalized, and the acknowledgement thereof before said magistrate shall be as valid and effectual as though said magistrate had been, at and before the time of taking such acknowledgement and making his certificate thereof, duly authorized by the laws of this State to take and certify the same, and that the record of said deed is legalized and confirmed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
