CHAPTER 344.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and eighty-one (281) of the Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventynine (1879), an act to prohibit the catching of fish in certain lakes and waters of Rice county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That chapter two hundred and eighty-one (281) of the Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879) relating to catching fish in certain lakes therein named be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and af-

ter its passage.

CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT relating to the catching of fish in Le Sueur county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. No person or persons shall hereafter catch, capture, spear, shoot, or in any manner destroy or take any fish or fishes during the months of December, January, February. March and up to April tenth (10th) of each and every year, within the waters of lakes or streams situated wholly or partly in Le Seuer county, Minnesota. *Provided*, the above shall not apply to the Minnesota river.

SEC. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of the preceding section of this act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than five (5) nor more than twenty-five dollars (\$25), together with the cost of prosecution, and shall be committed to the county jail of Le Seuer county until such fine and costs are paid. *Provided*, such imprisonment shall not be more than sixty (60) days nor less than ten (10) days.

SEC. 3. It shall be the duty of any person or persons having knowledge of the violation of any of the provisions of this act to make complaint thereof to any justice of the peace in and for the
