SEC. 4. Before any incorporation shall be had under this act, the same shall be voted upon and decided by ballot, by a majority of the legal voters of said territory, said election to be called upon notices by said commissioners or a majority of the same, as the election of the officers provided in chapter one hundred and thirtynine, (139), of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, (1875).

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 45.

A BILL TO SET APART FOR INCORPORATION AS A VILLAGE CER-TAIN TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAKOTA UNDER THE NAME OF THE VILLAGE OF VERMILION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. The following described territory in the county of Dakota, in this State. to-wit: The south half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of section fifteen (15) and the north half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of section twenty-two (22) all in township one hundred and fourteen (114) north, of range eighteen (18) west, be and the same is hereby set apart for incorporation as a village in pursuance of the general laws of the State of Minnesota under the name and style of the village of Vermilion.

SEC. 2. That Joseph Larson, Gillis Krunsen and Michael Kirst be and hereby are designated to take the requisite steps and do all acts and things necessary to organize the said village under and in pursuance of the said general law.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
