# CHAPTER 48.

# AN ACT TO ORGANIZE THE VILLAGE OF WAVERLY, IN WRIGHT COUNTY.

# Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The following described territory be and the same is hereby set apart for incorporation as a village by the name of Waverly, to-wit: The north half  $(\frac{1}{2})$  and the northwest quarter  $(\frac{1}{4})$  of section four (4) in township one hundred and eighteen (118) in range twenty-six (26), the south half  $(\frac{1}{2})$  of the southwest quarter  $(\frac{1}{4})$  of section thirty-three (33) in township one hundred and nineteen (119), range twenty-six (26) all in Wright county, Minnesota.

SEC. 2. Patrick Fallihee, Wm. Quinn and J. K. Cullen are hereby designated as the persons who shall take the steps by law required to secure the incorporation of the said village.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from its passage.

#### CHAPTER 49.

### AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF WHITE BEAR IN THE COUNTY OF RAMSEY, STATE OF MINNESOTA.

# Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. All that part of the county of Ramsey, State of Minnesota, within the limits and boundaries hereinafter described shall be a village by the name of White Bear, and the people now inhabiting and those who shall hereinafter inhabit within the district of country herein described, shall be a municipal corporation by the name of the village of White Bear, who shall have the general powers possessed by municipal corporations at common law, and in addition thereto shall possess the powers hereinafter granted, and the authorities thereof shall have perpetual succession; shall be capable of sueing and being sued, pleading and being impleaded in all courts of law and equity, of contracting and being contracted with, and shall have a common seal, and may alter or change the same at pleasure, and may take, hold, and purchase,
