

CHAPTER 98

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FOUR (4) OF THE SPECIAL LAW OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR (1874,) INCORPORATING THE VILLAGE OF WILLMAR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section of sixteen (16) of chapter four (4) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (1874) be amended by adding at the close of said section the following:

And provided, further, that the town of Willmar shall not be authorized to assess, levy, or collect any road tax whatsoever upon any property real or personal situate within the corporate limits of the village of Willmar, and the respective officers of said town of Willmar are hereby prohibited from assessing, levying or collecting any road tax whatsoever upon any property situate within the village of Willmar.

And provided, further, that the village council of the village of Willmar shall have the power and authority to assess a road tax on all the personal and real property situate within the corporate limits of said village of Willmar, not to exceed three (3) mills on the dollar, for the improvement of the streets and roads within the corporate limits of said village, said tax to be assessed, levied and collected in the same manner as personal and land road tax is by law authorized to be assessed, levied and collected by town officers. Said village council to have the powers and exercise the duties of town supervisors in such regard. The village recorder to perform the duties by law conferred upon town clerks in such regard. And the street commissioner of said village to perform the duties in such regard imposed on overseers of highways.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
