## JOINT RESOLUTIONS.

## NUMBER 1.

A JOINT RESOLUTION REQUESTING CONGRESS TO FIX THE HEAD OF NAVIGATION OF THE MINNESOTA RIVER.

WHEREAS, The Minnesota river is not a navigable river west of the eastern line of the county of Redwood; and

Preamble.

WHEREAS, That in law it is considered as navigable, to the great expense and detriment of the people residing near said river, west of said point, in the matter of bridging it for highway purposes, and the improvement of milling privileges, therefore.

Be it Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That our Senators and Representatives in Congress be requested to urge immediate action and to procure a resolution of Congress fixing the head of navigation of the Minnesota river at the point where the range line between ranges thirty- Resolution. three (33) and thirty-four (34), west of the fifth (5th) principal meridian, crosses said river, said range line being the eastern boundary of Redwood county.

Resolved, That the Secretary of State is requested to forward copies of this resolution to each of our Senators and

Representatives in Congress.
