CHAPTER 112.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF WHITE BEAR TO HOLD THEIR ELECTIONS AND TOWN MEETINGS IN THE VILLAGE OF WHITE BEAR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all elections, either annual, town or special, and all town meetings, for the town of White Bear, in the county of Ramsey, may be held in the village of White Bear in said county, at such place as the supervisors of said town of White Bear, may from time to time fix and determine.

SEC. 2. This act to be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 113.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SCOTT COUNTY, AND LEGALIZING A MEETING.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The board of county commissioners of the county of Scott are hereby authorized and directed to hold a special meeting at the court house in said county, commencing on the 27th day of October, 1881, for the transaction of any business which may

properly cone before said board.

SEC. 2. The meeting of said board of county commissioners held since the death of the county auditor of said county is hereby legalized, and the auditor of said county (when one shall be appointed and qualified) is hereby authorized to issue warrants to said commissioners for per diem and mileage at said meeting, and the one authorized to be held by section one, at the rates provided by law.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
