their services, but in the aggregate not to exceed one hundred (\$100) dollars unless provision shall have been made to pay the excess, so as not to render the county of Ramsey liable.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage.

CHAPTER 119.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ST. PAUL TO MAKE AN AP-PROPRIATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF FORT STREET

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the common council of the city of St. Paul is hereby authorized and empowered by a three-fourths vote of all the members elect to issue the bonds of the city of St. Paul to an amount not exceeding ten thousand dollars for the purpose of aiding in the grading, paving, or macadamizing Fort street, from the seven corners, so called, to the city limits. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate not to exceed four per cent. per annum, and shall be payable when and where the common council may order and determine. *Provided*, however, that none of said bonds shall be sold less than par.

SEC. 2 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 120.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF HENNEPIN TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE NAVIGATION OF LAKE MINNETONKA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The board of county commissioners of the county of Hennepin, are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to appropriate such sum of money as may be necessary, not exceeding the sum of ten thousand (10,000) dollars in the aggregate, out of any money in the county revenue fund, not otherwise appropriated, for the improvement of the navigation of Lake Minnetonka upon that part of said Lake commonly called and known as "The Narrows."
