the same is hereby detached from school district number two (2)

in Nicollet county.

That the west half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter section twenty (20), town one hundred and ten (110), range twenty-six (26) west, be and the same is hereby detached from school district number twenty-seven (27), and that the south half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the southeast quarter section nineteen (19), town one hundred and ten (110), range twenty-six (26) west, be and the same is hereby detached from school district number thirty-eight (38) and attach all of said detached territory to independent school district number one (1) in Nicollet county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 134.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-TWO (152)
OF SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE (1881), CHANGING THE BOUNDARIES OF INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER TWENTY-EIGHT (28), IN DODGE
COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and fifty-two (152), of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and and eighty-one (1881), being an act to change the boundaries of Independent school district number twenty-eight (28), in Dodge county, is hereby repealed.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the south half($\frac{1}{2}$) of section thirty-five (35), town one hundred and nineteen (119), range twenty-four (24), be detached from school district number seventy-seven (77), in the
