

providing otherwise, and all such conveyances heretofore executed and the records of the same when recorded, if good and sufficient in other respects, are hereby legalized and made valid to all intents and purposes for which the same were severally executed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

#### CHAPTER 207.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR "THE NORTH STAR BARREL COMPANY," "THE CO-OPERATIVE BARREL MANUFACTURING COMPANY," "THE HENNEPIN COUNTY BARREL COMPANY," AND THE "PHOENIX BARREL MANUFACTURING COMPANY," CORPORATIONS HERETOFORE ORGANIZED TO REORGANIZE UNDER CHAPTER TWENTY-NINE (29), OF THE LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY (1870), RELATING TO CO-OPERATIVE ASSOCIATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the North Star Barrel Company, the Co-operative Barrel Manufacturing Company, the Hennepin County Barrel Company and the Phoenix Barrel Manufacturing Company, corporations heretofore organized or attempted to be organized, under title two (2), chapter thirty-four (34), of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), may conform their articles to the provisions of chapter twenty-nine (29), of the laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy (1870) and the several amendments thereto, and file the same in the office of the city clerk of the city of Minneapolis, in the county of Hennepin, Minnesota, where said corporations carry on their business, and thereafter and without any other act or ceremony, shall become entitled to all the rights, benefits and privileges conferred by said chapter twenty-nine (29), of the laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy (1870), and the several amendments thereto; and all grants, transfers and conveyances by the state or any person or corporation to either of said corporations herein named heretofore, made are hereby confirmed unto such corporations, and shall upon filing its articles in the office of the city clerk, of Minneapolis, as provided in this section, be deemed to accrue and enure to the benefit of such corporations as thus organized without any other act or ceremony whatever.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
