## CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER TWENTY-THREE (23), SPECIAL LAWS ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), BEING AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF LANSING, MOWER COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter twenty-three (23), special laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), be

and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section one (1): That the southwest quarter of section two (2), the southeast quarter of section three (3), the northwest quarter of section eleven (11), the northeast quarter of section ten (10), and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section three (3), all in township one hundred and three (103) north, of range eighteen (1) west, in Mower county, is hereby set apart and incorporated as the village of Lansing, under the provisions of chapter one hundred and thirty-nine (139), of the general laws of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five (1875) and the amendments thereto, and shall be and is hereby constituted a separate voting precinct for all purposes, *Provided*, the township and general elections may be held in the said village of Lansing.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

## CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED: AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF WHITE BEAR, IN THE COUNTY OF RAMSEY AND STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of an act entitled: An act to amend an act to incorporate the village of White Bear, in the county of Ramsey, State of Minnesota, approved February 28th, 1881, by excluding therefrom the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section number fourteen (14), and lots number two (2) and three (3), of section twenty-three (23), of township number thirty (80), range number twenty-two (22) west, according to government survey.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
