

CHAPTER 55

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF ST. PAUL TO ISSUE BONDS FOR THE REPAIR OR REBUILDING OF CERTAIN BRIDGES AND APPROACHES AND THE OPENING OF A STREET, APPROVED FEBRUARY NINE, ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of an act to authorize the city of St. Paul to issue bonds for the repair or rebuilding of certain bridges and approaches and the opening of a street, approved February 9, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), is hereby amended so as to increase the amount of bonds authorized to be issued for the construction of the approaches to a bridge to be built on Lafayette Avenue over Trout Brook, six thousand dollars (\$6,000).

SEC. 2. This act to be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 56.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIXTEEN SUBDIVISION NINTH CHAPTER TWO SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN-HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That subdivision ninth of section sixteen be and is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to wit:

Ninth—To levy a tax on dogs, and prohibit their running at large; to authorize their destruction when at large contrary to ordinance, and to impose fines upon their owners.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
