CHAPTER 93.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SCOTT COUNTY, TO ISSUE BONDS TO BUILD A JAIL AND SHER-1FF'S RESIDENCE IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The board of county commissioners of the county of Scott, State of Minnesota, is hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of said county, not to exceed in amount the sum of five thousand (\$5,000) dollars with interest coupons attached, for the purpose of building a county jail and sheriff's residence at

the county seat of said county.

SEC. 2. Said bonds shall be issued in such denominations and for such time, not exceeding five (5) years, as said commissioners shall determine; shall bear interest at the rate of six (6) per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually; shall not be negotiated for less than par; the proceeds thereof, shall not be used for any purpose except the building and completion ready for occupancy of such jail and sheriff's residence; and only so much of said bonds shall be issued as may be necessary for that purpose.

Sec. 3. The said board of county commissioners shall, annually, after issuing said bonds, assess and levy a tax upon all taxable property of said county, (which may be in addition to all other taxes authorized to be levied), sufficient in amount to pay the interest and principal of said bonds as the same shall become due.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 94.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER ONE (1) OF SCOTT COUNTY, TO ISSUE A BOND.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the board of trustees of school district number one (1) of Scott county, are hereby authorized to issue and negotiate a bond of said district of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars, payable in five (5) years with interest coupons attached; interest to be at the rate of six (6) per cent. per annum payable semi-annually. Sec. 2. Said bond shall not be negotiated for less than par, and

ing of the school house in said district.
