CHAPTER 101.

AN ACT IN RELATION TO COUNTER-CLAIMS AND OFF-SETS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

Section 1. The pleading of a set-off or counter-claim by a defendant in any action, in any of the courts of this state shall not be held or construed to be an admission of counter Claims. any cause of action on the part of the plaintiff against such defendant.

All laws inconsistent herewith are hereby re-SEG. 2.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 102.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE DISCHARGE OF ATTACHMENTS ON REAL ESTATE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That subdivision four (4) of section one hundred and sixty (160) of chapter sixty-six (66) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be amended by adding, after the word "action" in the third (3d) line of said subdivision, the words "or by the attorney of record of the said plaintiff."
