Statutes of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be amended by adding the words "burdock and wild mustard or burdocks or wild mustard immediately after the words Canada thistle or thistles" wherever they shall occur in said sections.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 36.

## AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIX (6), CHAPTER FIFTEEN (15) OF GENERAL STATUTES OF A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO RELIEF OF THE POOR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section six (6) of chapter fifteen (15) of the General Statutes of A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), is amended by adding at the end thereof the following words, to wit: *Provided* further that if in the opinion of the county

*Provided* further that if in the opinion of the county commissioners a limited amount of aid will suffice to enable a person or family who would otherwise have to be sent to the poor house to be self-supporting they may provide for the partial support of such person or persons in any way which they may deem proper.

SEC. 2. Provided this act shall apply to Goothue county only.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
