

CHAPTER 196.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO AID THE COUNTY OF BECKER TO BUILD BRIDGES ACROSS THE STREAMS BETWEEN CARSONVILLE AND DETROIT CITY, IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the sum of seven hundred dollars (\$700) out of any money belonging to the internal improvement fund not otherwise appropriated, or out of the first (1st) money that shall come into the said internal improvement fund, be and hereby is appropriated to aid the county of Becker to build bridges across the streams between Carsonville and Detroit City, in said county.

SEC. 2. That the county commissioners of Becker county shall have charge of [the building of] the bridges mentioned in the first (1st) section of this act, and cause said bridges to be well and substantially built, and when completed shall report the fact with the cost of each bridge and the aggregate cost of all to the state auditor.

SEC. 3. The state auditor shall upon the receipt of such report draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the amount stated in said report, not however to exceed the sum of seven hundred dollars (\$700), which said warrant shall be drawn in favor of the county treasurer of said Becker county.

SEC. 4. The state treasurer shall, on the presentation of such warrant, pay the amount therein stated to the county treasurer of said county.

SEC. 5. The county treasurer shall receive the money and pay the same out to the persons entitled thereto, as directed by the commissioners of said county, who shall by resolution designate the persons and the amount each is entitled to receive.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
