

CHAPTER 237.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT RELATING TO ORGANIZATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN CASS COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the first section of chapter one hundred and twenty-seven (127), of the special laws of the state of Minnesota, passed during the extra session of the state legislature, of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. That all that part of the county of Cass in the state of Minnesota, except so much thereof as is included in any Indian reservation, lying east of the line separating ranges thirty-one (31) and thirty-two (32), and the people now or hereafter inhabiting said territory, be, and the same hereby are organized and constituted a school district and body corporate, and shall be known as "School District number one (1), of Cass county," with all the rights, powers and privileges appertaining to or possessed by the common school districts of this state, organized under the general laws of the state. That all elections of school officers, and the acts done by the electors or officers of school district number one (1), as constituted by said chapter one hundred and twenty-seven (127), of the special laws of the extra session of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), including the issuing of bonds, are hereby legalized and confirmed, and made the acts of school district number one (1) of Cass county, as constituted by this act; and all bonds which have been issued by school district number one (1), under said chapter one hundred and twenty-seven (127), or otherwise, are hereby legalized and confirmed, and made the debt of school district number one (1) of Cass county, as in this act organized and described.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
