

## CHAPTER 252.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN ACKNOWLEDGMENTS OF DEEDS AND OTHER INSTRUMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That all acknowledgments of deeds and other instruments taken, and all other acts done and performed by P. O. Noben, in the capacity of a notary public, [in and] for the county of Otter Tail, and state of Minnesota, between the fifteenth (15th) day of June, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), and the second (2d) day of November, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), be and the same are hereby declared legal and shall have, and the record thereof shall have all the binding effect as if the same were taken, and performed by a duly commissioned notary public in and for said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 253.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE BONDS [ISSUED] BY THE TOWN OF LOGAN, IN GRANT COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the issuing and negotiating by the board of supervisors of the town of Logan, in the county of Grant, of the bonds authorized by chapter two hundred and forty-two (242), of the Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), for the purpose of building a court house in the village of Herman, and the using of the moneys received from the sale of said bonds for said purpose, be and the same is hereby declared legal, and said bonds are declared valid obligations of said town of Logan.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
