CHAPTER 264.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN RECORDS FROM ROCK COUNTY TO PIPESTONE COUNTY, AND DECLARING THE EFFECT THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That all plats, records, books and other papers, apper taining exclusively to Pipestone county, which are now filed or recorded in the office of the register of deeds, of Rock county, shall be torthwith transferred from Rock county to Pipestone county. And the register of deeds, of Rock county, is hereby authorized to deliver such plats, records, books and other papers, to the register of deeds of Pipestone county, and after such transfer said plats and records shall continue to be of full force and effect, and shall constitute a part of the official records in the office of the register of deeds, of Pipestone county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage.

CHAPTER 265

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE ACROSS THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER AT BRAINERD, IN CROW WING COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the county commissioners of Crow Wing county or such commissioners if any as may be appointed in behalf of the state, for the purpose as hereby authorized to erect a bridge across the Mississippi river at the west end of Laurel street, in the city of Brainerd, *Provided*, That such bridge shall not be of less elevation than forty-six feet (46) above the high water mark over the channel of said river; nor shall the span of such bridge crossing the main channel of the river be less than one hundred feet (100) in length; and the piers of said bridge shall be as nearly as practicable parallel with the current of said bridge.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
