CHAPTER 282.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE SALARY OF AUDITOR OF THE COUNTY OF ANOKA, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter two hundred and forty-nine (249) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), being an act entitled An act regulating the salary of the county auditor of the county of Anoka, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 283.

AN ACT TO FIX THE COMPENSATION AND CLERK HIRE OF CERTAIN OFFICERS IN WASHINGTON COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the salary of the county auditor of the county of Washington be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per annum, and the salary of the county treasurer of said county be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of two

thousand dollars (\$2,000) per annum.

SEC. 2. That the county auditor of said county shall be allowed such necessary clerk hire as he may require, not exceeding the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per annum, the same to be allowed, audited and paid by and under the direction of the board of county commissioners of said county. The county treasurer shall be allowed such necessary clerk hire as he may require, not exceeding the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) per annum, the same to be allowed, audited and paid by and under the direction of the board of county commissioners of said county.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith, are hereby

repealed.
SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first (1st) day of March A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-

three (1883). Approved March 1, 1883.
