

CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE MINNESOTA AND NORTHWESTERN RAILROAD COMPANY.

As enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the Minnesota and Northwestern Railroad Company, created, organized and existing by and under an act of the legislature of the Territory of Minnesota entitled "An act to incorporate the Minnesota and Northwestern Railroad Company," approved March fourth (4th), one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four (1854), and its amendatory thereto, is hereby authorized to consolidate its stock, franchises, rights and property with that of any other railroad company which will undertake the construction and operation of the railroad which the said Minnesota and Northwestern Railroad Company is authorized to construct and operate.

SEC. 2. The seventh section of said original act incorporating the Minnesota and Northwestern Railroad Company is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7. The said corporation is hereby authorized and empowered to survey, locate, construct, complete, alter, maintain and operate as a railroad, with one (1) or more tracks or lines of rails, with all necessary bridges, from such a point on the northern boundary of the State of Minnesota as the board of directors of said corporation shall designate, westerly, by way of the cities of St. Paul and Minneapolis, to the northern boundary of this State.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
