Provided, however, That when such vacancy occurs in the office of alderman or police justice, the person appointed to fill such vacancy shall hold such office until the next city election and until his successor shall be elected and qualified; And pr vided further, That such successor shall hold such office only during such unexpired term.

CHAPTER 9.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF BRAINERD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of chapter (2) of chapter eighteen (18) of the special laws of the extra session of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words and figure "one (1) justice," in the second line in said section and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figure "two (2) justices."

SEC. 2. That wherever the words "police justice" appears in said chapter eighteen (18) of said special laws, the same shall be changed

to read "police justices." SEC. 3. That section seven (7) of said chapter two (2) of said chapter eighteen (18) be amended by striking out all that part of said section after the word "election" in the tenth line thereof. SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
