

CHAPTER 108.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION EIGHTY-FOUR (84), TITLE EIGHT (8), CHAPTER SIX (6), GENERAL STATUTES [OF] ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO RETURNS OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section eighty-four (84) of title eight (8), chapter six (6) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be and the same is hereby amended by adding after the word "December," in the fifth (5th) line of said section, "the said clerk of the district court shall issue his certificate to the said clerk of the said town or city, showing the amount due him for said returns, and upon the presentation of said certificate to the county auditor of the county in which said births and deaths are recorded, then the said auditor shall issue his warrant for the whole amount found to be due said clerk for said returns

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 109.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS FORTY-SIX (46) AND FIFTY-FOUR (54) OF CHAPTER SEVENTY-THREE (73), GENERAL LAWS ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE (1883), INCORPORATING VILLAGES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section forty-six (46) of chapter seventy-three (73), general laws one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following subdivision after subdivision seven (7), as the section now is.

Subdivision eight (8). To keep a correct record of all the births and deaths occurring in the village, as is now required by city and town clerks, with same law penalty and fees.
