

CHAPTER 113.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION EIGHTY (80), CHAPTER SIX (6), OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO THE DUTIES OF TOWNSHIP ASSESSORS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section eighty (80) of chapter six (6) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight (1878) is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: The township assessors shall receive as compensation for making the statement required by this section to be returned to the county auditor, at the rate of ten (10) cents for each form so returned, which said sum shall be paid by the state. Upon the return of said abstract statement to the county auditor, if the same is correctly made out, he shall issue an order to the assessor for the amount due him on the treasury of the state, which said order shall be received in payment of state taxes.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 114.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FORTY-EIGHT (48) OF CHAPTER ELEVEN (11) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section forty-eight (48) of chapter eleven (11) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be and the same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "annually," in the seventh (7th) line of said section, the following: He shall also notify each county auditor of the amount due the state from his county on account of school text-books furnished

such county, and it shall then be the duty of said county auditor so notified to levy a tax sufficient to meet such indebtedness, which tax shall be levied and collected and paid into the state treasury in the same manner as other state taxes.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 115.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR (34) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), TO PROVIDE FOR THE INCORPORATION OF POSTS OF THE GRAND ARMY OF THE REPUBLIC.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That chapter thirty-four (34) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

Title 10, Sec. 427. That any post of the Grand Army of the Republic of the state of Minnesota may become incorporated in the manner provided herein.

How incorporated.

Sec. 428. Such post shall cause to be prepared a certificate which shall contain:

First—The charter, name and number of such post.

What certificate to contain.

Second—The time when and the authority by which such post was instituted.

Third—The names of the charter members of such post.

Fourth—The name of its commander, senior vice commander, junior vice commander, and adjutant for the current term of such post.

Such certificate shall be signed by the commander, senior vice commander, junior vice commander and adjutant of such post, and shall be recorded in the office of the register of deeds of the county where such post is located.

Sec. 429. Upon filing such certificate in the office of such register of deeds such post shall become a body corporate, under its charter, name and number, and shall have and possess all the powers of corporations at common law, and shall have power to sue and be sued by its corpor-
