CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SEVENTY-FOUR (74) OF CHAP-TER THIRTY-SIX (36), GENERAL STATUTES ONE THOU-SAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), PRO-VIDING FOR ASSISTANT COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section seventy-four (74) of chapter thirty-six (36), general statutes one thousand eight hundved and seventy-eight (1878) be amended by adding thereto the following: That in any county having one hundred assistant of [and] seventy-five (175) or more organized school districts, schools—when. the county superintendent of schools of such county may appoint an assistant superintendent of schools, said appointment to be confirmed by the board of county commissioners. The duties of such assistant superintendent shall be, to assist in all the general duties prescribed to be done by the county superintendent, under whose direction the same shall be performed, and to whom report shall be made. The salary of Compensation. such assistant superintendent shall be fixed by the board of county commissioners at any amount not to exceed fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500) per annum, to be paid monthly as salaries of other county officers.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from When act to take effect. and after its passage.
