## CHAPTER 128.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWENTY-THREE (23) OF CHAP-TER FIFTY-SEVEN (57) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO SALES OF LANDS BY GUARDIANS IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section number twenty-three (23) of chapter fifty-seven (57) of the statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 23. When the goods, chattels, rights, and credits when may sell in the hands of a guardian are insufficient to pay all the debts of the ward with the charges of managing the estate, the guardian may be licensed to sell or mortgage the real estate of his ward in like manner and upon like terms and conditions as are prescribed in this chapter in the case of a sale by executors or administrators, except as hereinafter provided; Provided, That no guardián shall be licensed to mortgage the real estate of his ward for any purpose except to pay the debts of his ward contracted prior to his appointment as guardian; Provided further, That no guardian shall be licensed to mortgage the real estate of his ward for a longer period than three (3) years from the granting of such license.

## CHAPTER 129.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE SELECTION, LOCATION AND APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN LANDS IN THE COUNTY OF HENNEPIN AND STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR A STATE PARK FOR HORTICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL STATE EXHIBIT GROUNDS, AND FOR THE LOCATION OF OTHER STATE IN-STITUTIONS AND BUILDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
