## CHAPTER 20.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER THIRTY-NINE (39) OF THE GENERAL LWAS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE (1883), RELATING TO STATE TEXT BOOKS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Chapter thirty-nine (39) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), be and the same is hereby amended, as follows: Insert immediately preceding section one (1) the words, "be it enacted by the legislature of the state of Minnesota," and amend section one (1) by striking out from lines thirtyeight (38) and thirty-nine (39) of the same as printed in the printed volume of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), the words: "after the passage of this act and annually thereafter," and insert in lieu thereof the words, "in January of each year and in case of any failure to make the appointment at said meeting, then the said board shall make the same at their next meeting and not later than the fifteenth (15) day of Also add after the words, "sale of such books" in the forty-first (41st) line of said section one (1) the words, "and such agents shall continue in office till the fifteenth (15th) day of January next succeeding, and until their successors are appointed and qualified."

## CHAPTER 21.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWENTY-SIX (26) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND SEVEN (107,) OF THE GENERAL STAT-UTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVEN-TY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO THE DISCHARGE OF THE GRAND JURY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section twenty-six (26) of chapter one hundred and seven (107) be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
