

## CHAPTER 215.

AN ACT TO TRANSFER TO THE CUSTODY AND CONTROL OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA THE LANDS GRANTED BY CONGRESS TO THE STATE BY AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT GRANTING LANDS TO THE STATE OF MINNESOTA IN LIEU OF CERTAIN LANDS HERETOFORE GRANTED TO SAID STATE," APPROVED MARCH THIRD (3D), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (1879), TO AUTHORIZE THE SAID BOARD TO SELL SUCH LANDS AND DISPOSE OF THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH SALES.

WHEREAS, The state lands known as state salt lands were by an act approved March ten (10), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three (1873), chapter one hundred and thirty-three (133), general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three (1873), transferred to the custody and control of the board of regents of the university of Minnesota, to be by said regents sold and the proceeds thereof held in trust by them, and disbursed in accordance with the law ordering a geological and natural history survey of the state; and,

WHEREAS, It was found that certain parcels of such state salt lands had been otherwise disposed of by the United States to actual settlers upon such lands for which indemnity lands have since been granted to this state by act of congress, approved March three (3), one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine (1879); therefore

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the lands granted by congress to this state by an act entitled "An act granting lands to the state of Minnesota in lieu of certain lands heretofore granted to said state," approved March three (3), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879), be and the same are hereby transferred to the custody and control of the board of regents of the university of Minnesota, which lands the said board may sell in such amounts as they may deem most expedient and beneficial, the proceeds thereof being held in trust by them, and only disbursed in accordance with the law ordering a geological and natural history survey of the state, and the said board shall make report of their doings in the premises, as provided by law.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
