CHAPTER 240.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE PENAL CODE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the secretary of state be and he hereby is authorized and directed to publish or cause to be published the penal code of the state of Minnesota, passed at the present session of the legislature in a volume by itself, and to omit said code from the volume of the general laws of this session. Such publication shall be made under the supervision of the attorney general and shall include such citation of authorities as the attorney general may direct and furnish.

SEC. 2. That the sum of one thousand (1,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of providing for any deficiency that such publication may cause in the general appropriation for the publication of the laws.
