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## CHAPTER 242.

AN ACT FOR THE RELIEF OF GEORGE BOLAN, AND TO APPROPRIATE MONEY THEREFOR.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The sum of fifteen hundred (\$1500) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the relief of George Bolan, who was injured by a premature blast while in the employ of the state of Minnesota.

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## CHAPTER 243.

AN ACT FOR THE RELIEF OF MARY A. OGELSBY, LATE MATRON TO THE FIFTH MINNESOTA INFANTRY VOLUNTEERS, AND TO APPROPRIATE MONEY THEREFOR.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys

in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, and paid to Mary A. Ogelsby, as indemnity for services rendered by the said Mary A. Ogelsby as matron to the Fifth Minnesota Infantry Volunteers at Fort Snelling, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two (1862), and for moneys due her by the soldiers and lost on the person of Sergeant Findly, killed by the Indians.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 244.

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE L. H. MCKUSICK FOR EXPENSES  
INCURRED IN A CONTESTED ELECTION.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand (1,000) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to L. H. McKusick out of any moneys, in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse him for moneys expended in the contested election case of William H. Wynkoop against L. H. McKusick, for a seat in the house of representatives, for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty five (1885).
