

## CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SEVENTY-SIX (76) OF CHAPTER NINETY-FIVE (95) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PROPERTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section seventy-six (76) of chapter ninety-five (95) of the general statutes of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be amended by adding thereto the following: And *provided further*, That none of the provisions of this or the foregoing section shall apply to any case when the board of county commissioners drain any such lake under the provisions of chapter one hundred and eight (108) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-three (1883).

What cases not applicable.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 29.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THIRTY-THREE (33) OF CHAPTER THIRTEEN (13) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO ROADS, CARTWAYS AND BRIDGES.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section thirty-three (33) of said chapter thirteen (13) be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 33. The supervisors of the town may alter or discontinue any road, or lay out any new road, upon the petition of not less than six (6) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the state of Minnesota, within one mile of the road to be altered, discontinued or laid out; or upon the petition of

When roads may be altered or discontinued.
