

CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THREE HUNDRED AND FORTY-SEVEN (347) OF TITLE SIX (6), CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR (34), GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO TOWN INSURANCE COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section three hundred and forty-seven (347) of said chapter thirty-four (34) be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "while on the premises or running at large." Strike out.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER 85.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIXTY-ONE (61) OF CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR (34) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, RELATING TO RAILROAD CROSSINGS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section sixty-one (61) of chapter thirty-four (34) of the general statutes of the state of Minnesota be amended and the same is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following proviso: *Provided, however,* And in case such two railroads crossing each other, or in any way connecting at a common grade, shall, by any works or fixtures to be erected by them, or either of them, render it safe to pass over said crossings without stopping, and such works or fixtures shall first be approved by the railroad commissioner, and the plan of such works or fixtures for such crossing, designating the place of such crossing, shall have been filed with said railroad commissioner; then, and [in] that case, the foregoing provisions of this section requiring Requiring stoppage of trains, not to apply.
