

CHAPTER 170.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF ST. PAUL TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO AID IN THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE ST. PAUL AND SHAKOPEE ROAD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of St. Paul be and is hereby authorized to appropriate and expend in the improvement of the St. Paul and Shakopee road between the city of St. Paul and Mendota, in the county of Dakota, a sum not to exceed eight thousand (8,000) dollars, upon such terms and conditions and restrictions as the said common council may impose; *Provided, however;* That as a condition precedent to the expenditure of any of the money authorized by this act, the towns of Mendota, Egan town and Burnsville town shall cause to be paid into the city treasury of the city of St. Paul the sum of two thousand (2,000) dollars, which said sum shall be taken and considered a part of the eight thousand (8,000) dollars herein named and so expended upon said road; *Provided,* That no part of said sum shall be expended upon bridges on said road, and the common council of the city of St. Paul is hereby authorized to issue certificates of indebtedness or warrants payable out of the general fund of said city to make the payment for the work authorized by this act.

SEC. 2. No money shall be expended under the provisions of this act until the said road is laid out and is a legal road, and the right of way vested in the public, from the limits of said city of St. Paul to said Mendota.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
