SPECIAL LAWS

CHAPTER 174.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE REMOVAL OF THE DEAD BURIED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE HIGHWAY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF VIOLA, OLM-STED COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the board of supervisors of the township of Viola, in the county of Olmsted, are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to remove, or cause to be removed, the remains of certain persons buried within the limits of the public highway adjoining the cemetery in said town of Viola, and to deposit the remains of such deceased persons in a suitable place within said adjoining cemetery, the necessary expenses of such removal to be paid out of any moneys belonging to said town not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
