

CHAPTER 207.

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBERED ONE (1) OF POLK COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all [of] sections numbered seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), sixteen (16), seventeen (17), eighteen (18), twenty-one (21), twenty-eight (28), and all that portion of section thirty-three (33), lying north of Red Lake river, all in township numbered one hundred and fifty (150) north, of range numbered forty-six (46) west, in the county of Polk, and state of Minnesota, be and the same is hereby detached from independent school district numbered one (1) of Polk county aforesaid.

SEC. 2. All taxes levied on said detached territory for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four (1884), and prior years, to be paid to, and collected by, said independent school district number one (1).

SEC. 3. The scholars residing in said detached territory shall be allowed to attend the public schools in said independent school district during the balance of the present school year.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
