

CHAPTER 256.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE SALARY OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY OF
OTTER TAIL COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The salary of the county attorney of the county of Otter Tail shall be in such amount per annum, not exceeding the sum of two thousand (2,000) dollars, as shall be fixed and prescribed by the board of county commissioners of said Otter Tail county, and the same shall be paid in equal monthly installments out of the county treasury of said county, upon the warrant of the auditor of said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 257.

AN ACT FOR COMPENSATION TO THE JUDGES OF THE DISTRICT COURT
OF THE FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there shall be paid annually by the county commissioners of Hennepin county, out of the county funds, to the judges of the district court of the fourth (4th) judicial district, in addition to the salaries allowed them by the general laws of the state of Minnesota, the sum of five hundred (500) dollars each, payable quarterly.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
