

CHAPTER 270.

AN ACT TO PERMIT FISHING WITH NETS IN THE LAKES SITUATED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF BARSNESS, IN POPE COUNTY, OF THIS STATE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for any person or persons to catch or capture fish, with nets, in any of the lakes within the limits of the township of Barsness, in Pope county, of this state, at any time during the year, except between the fifteenth (15th) day of March and the fifteenth (15th) day of May of each year; *Provided*, That the meshes of said nets are not less than two (2) inches in diameter.

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 271.

AN ACT TO PREVENT FISHING WITH A SEINE IN THE RIVER ZUMBRO AND ITS BRANCHES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, at any time during the year, to use any seine or trap of any kind whatever, except hook and line or spear, in catching or taking fish in the Zumbro river or any of its branches.

SEC. 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of the preceding section shall, upon conviction thereof, pay a fine of five (5) dollars for each and every fish so caught, killed or taken, together with costs of prosecution.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
