

CHAPTER 279.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE CATCHING OF FISH IN CHISAGO LAKE AND IN GREEN LAKE. IN THE COUNTY OF CHISAGO, AND TO PROHIBIT SHIPPING OUT OF SAID COUNTY ANY FISH CAUGHT IN SAID LAKES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to catch, capture, kill or destroy, except by hook and line, or by spear, any fish or fishes in Chisago lake and in Green lake, in Chisago county, Minnesota.

SEC. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to ship or carry out of said Chisago county, in any manner whatsoever, any fish or fishes caught in the said Chisago lake or Green lake, in said county and state.

SEC. 3. Whoever violates the provisions of the preceding sections, or either of them, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before any justice of the peace shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten (10) dollars, nor more than fifty (50) dollars together with cost of prosecution, and on default in the payment thereof may be imprisoned in the county jail not exceeding thirty (30) days for each offense.

SEC. 4. All prosecutions under the provisions of this act shall be commenced by complaint, under oath, within sixty (60) days from the time the offense was committed, before any justice of the peace in said county, and all fines collected under the provisions of this act shall be paid in each case one-half (½) to the complainant and one-half (½) to the common school fund of the county.

SEC. 5. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
