

which shall be presented to the board of education and approved by them, then all the funds in the hands of the treasurer of the board of education, or thereafter received by him, shall be deposited in the said bank or banks, in the name of the board of education and subject to the order of the treasurer of the board. When the funds in the hands of the said treasurer shall have been placed in the bank or banks designated as aforesaid, such treasurer and his bondsmen shall be exempt from liability therefor by reason of the loss of any such deposited funds from the failure, bankruptcy, or any other acts of the said bank or banks, to the extent and amount of such funds in the hands of such bank or banks at the time of such failure or bankruptcy, or other acts aforesaid; but in all other cases the treasurer of the board of education and his bondsmen shall be liable for the full amount of all the funds at the disposal of said treasurer.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 291.

AN ACT TO PERFECT THE PLAT OF THE TOWNSITE OF CARMAN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It is hereby made the duty of the register of deeds, in and for the county of Polk, to perfect the plat of the townsite of Carman, which is now of record in his office, by marking accurately thereupon, in a proper manner, with red ink, the state subdivisions of the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section number thirty-six (36), in township number one hundred and fifty (150), of range number forty-seven (47).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
