

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER EIGHTY-SEVEN (87) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), APPROVED MARCH EIGHTH (8TH), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), RELATING TO THE VILLAGE OF RUSH CITY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of said chapter eighty-seven (87) be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "and councilors," in the fourth (4th) line of said section. Also by striking out all of said section after the word "qualified," in the eighth (8th) line of said section, and inserting the following: "At the next village election in said village, to be held on the sixth (6th) day of April, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), three councilors shall be elected to take the place of those now acting under the provisions of the chapter hereby amended."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FOUR (4) OF CHAPTER FOURTEEN (14) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (1879), ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF BLUE EARTH CITY, FARIBAULT COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section four (4) of chapter fourteen (14) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879), entitled "An act to incorporate the village of Blue Earth City, Faribault county, Minnesota," is hereby amended by adding to said section the following subdivision: "Twentieth—To prescribe the limits within which wooden buildings, or buildings of material that shall not be
