

CHAPTER 164.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN PERSONS FROM THE TRIAL OF CAUSES OF A SCANDALOUS OR OBSCENE NATURE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Exclusion of minors from certain trials.

SECTION 1. That when, in any court, a cause of a scandalous or obscene nature is on trial, the presiding judge or justice may, in his discretion, exclude therefrom all minors not necessarily present as parties or witnesses.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 165.

AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE STATE BOARD OF IMMIGRATION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

State board of immigration.

SECTION 1. That chapter seventy-six (76) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-seven (1877), providing for the establishment of a State Board of Immigration, and chapter thirty-four (34) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-one (1881) and chapter ninety-four (94) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-one (1881) and chapter one hundred and fifty-four, (154) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-three (1883), amendatory thereof, be and the same are hereby repealed.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
