

CHAPTER 211.

[H. F. No. 286.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE RELIEF OF SOLOMON PORTER, COUNTY TREASURER OF THE COUNTY OF KANDIYOHI, IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Whereas, Solomon Porter, county treasurer of the county of Kandiyohi, was on the night of the twenty-ninth (29) day of May, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), while acting in the capacity of treasurer of said county, robbed by one John Hultgren of the sum of about six thousand (6000) dollars, then and there in his possession as treasurer, of which sum eight hundred and fifty (850) dollars belonged to the state of Minnesota for taxes due said state of Minnesota from said county of Kandiyohi; said moneys being then and there in the safe of said county treasurer, and were feloniously taken therefrom without the knowledge, connivance or procurement of said county treasurer by the said John Hultgren; and

Relief of Solomon Porter.

Whereas, the said county treasurer, upon demand of the proper authorities, did pay and make good that loss to the state of Minnesota, from and out of his own personal properties without hindrance or expense; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the state treasurer of the state of Minnesota is hereby authorized to refund and pay over to the said Solomon Porter the sum of eight hundred and fifty (850) dollars, so by him paid into the state treasury, upon proper vouchers and receipts being filed by the said Solomon Porter.

SEC. 2. The sum of eight hundred and fifty (850) dollars is hereby appropriated for the purposes of this act, out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
